Tournament format

Open to 84 bowlers - All bowlers compete in their respective categories.

FFBSQ rule: U11 max 10 games/day, U14 max 12 games/day:

- U11 bowlers (born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2017) compete in U14 and bowl 3 games in series 1 & 2.
- The highest-ranked U11 bowler and the top 3 highest-ranked U14 bowlers after the qualifications qualify directly for the U14 Final4.
- U14 bowlers do not bowl the semi-finals.

Top 8 bowlers in categories girls, U17 boys and U21 boys advance to the semi-finals; not qualified bowlers are ranked by their total qualification score.

Semi-finals : 7-game round robin of 8 bowlers

13:00 – 14:45

Scoring: Win = 3 points, Tie = 1 point, Loss = 0 points.

Top 4 bowlers qualify for the Final 4.

Not qualified bowlers are ranked 5–8 according to their round-robin standings.

Final4 – Knockout Elimination Format

15:00 – 16:30

- All 4 bowlers bowl 2 games on one lane pair, starting from scratch. After 2 games, the bowler with the lowest total pinfall is ranked 4th.
- The remaining 3 bowlers continue to game 3, carrying over their total pinfall from games 1 & 2. After game 3, the bowler with the lowest cumulative pinfall (games 1–3) is ranked 3rd.
- The final 2 bowlers bowl one deciding game, starting from scratch. The bowler who scores the highest game wins the tournament; the other bowler is placed 2nd.

Tournament tie rules

<p>Qualifications & Semi-finals : In case of a tie, the athlete with the highest score in the most recent game ranks higher. If still tied, the next most recent game is used, and so on.</p> <p>Final4 : In case of a tie, a one-ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be bowled, repeated until the tie is broken.</p>
